DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR EGG WASHING AND SANITIZING: Dissolve 1 or 2 oz. of PARK MANOR EGG WASH AND SANITIZER in 10 gallons of warm water (125° F). This provides 100 or 200 ppm available chlorine. For immersion treatment, dip a basket of eggs in the 200 ppm available chlorine solution, hold for 2 or 3 minutes, remove, rinse with potable water and dry. With a conveyor type machine, spray with the 100 ppm available chlorine solution and follow with a potable water rinse. Destains as it cleans and sanitizes.

FOR DISHES, GLASSES, FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS: Dissolve 1 or 2 oz. of Park Manor Egg Wash and Sanitizer per 10 gallons of warm water (125° F). This provides 100 or 200 ppm available chlorine. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. Dip in a solution and hold for 2 or 3 minutes. Remove, rinse with potable water, and dry. Use same solutions in feed tank of immersion or spray type machines providing 2 to 5 minutes contact time for sanitizing. Rinse well with potable water and dry. The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing. If the solution is allowed to stand or is reused and tests show the level of chlorine has not been maintained, additional PM EGG WASH AND SANITIZER should be added to maintain a minimum concentration of 100 ppm available chlorine.
