

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Pelron 9570 has been primarily designed for use as a preservative in emulsifiable or soluble cutting oils and synthetic chemical coolant formulations. It is readily incorporated into cutting oil formulations by addition to the concentrate, coupled with moderate agitation. Pelron 9570 should be added to the concentrate to provide 1000 - 1500 ppm of product as is in the final use emulsion.

DILUTION RATES: Add 0.10 - 0.15% of Pelron 9570 (or 0.8 - 1.2 pints) per 100 gallons of diluted cutting fluid to use dilution.

For the make-up fluid, 0.10 - 0.15% of Pelron 9570 should be added to the use dilution.

Pelron 9570 in recommended use dilutions is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.

Pelron 9570 is a long-lasting, broad spectrum bacteriostat and fungistat for the preservation of soluble cutting oil, semi-synthetic and synthetic type metal working fluids, hydraulic fluids and chemical coolants. When used as directed, the product prolongs fluid life, and reduces the incidence of slime and odor formation.

Pelron 9570 is effective against aerobic, anaerobic and H₂S producing microorganisms and the odors they cause.
