Dear Mr. Assaf:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

First Aid section comment(s), page 1 of 2:

1. Replace the **HOT LINE NUMBER** portion of this section with the following:

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. For more information on this pesticide product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call 1-800-xxx-xxxx or the National Pesticide Information Center at 1-800-858-7378. ¹

Precautionary Statements section, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s), page 2 of 2:

2. Replace the existing 7th sentence with: "Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

Directions for Use section comment(s), page 2 of 2:

3. Replace the last text grouping with: "This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with the U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such use(s)."


SOPYRWA/Valent should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins.

¹ Please note that the "1-800-xxx-xxxx" must be substituted with a valid phone number that is available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.

Within forty-five (45) days from the date of this letter, you should submit a label amendment revising the "Warranty & Disclaimer" section of this label in accordance with the guidance document entitled, "Guidance on Warranty Statements" and dated October 17, 2006.
