

**PRECAUTIONARY
STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS
AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Keep out of reach of domestic animals. Do not use on humans, household pets or livestock. Do not permit children or pets to go into the sprayed grass until spray has completely dried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds and other wildlife treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment. Residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are visiting the crop, cover crop, or weeds blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture, or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.
Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place.
General: Consult Federal, State or Local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

ANIMAL USES: To control hornflies and lice, on beef cattle, hogs, and horses, dilute 1/2 pint of Methoxychlor E-2 in 3 gallons of water or 1 gallon of Methoxychlor E-2 in 50 gallons of water. Agitate thoroughly and apply as dip or with an effective sprayer, using a driving spray of medium sized droplets. Use about 2 quarts of spray per beef animal and a proportionate amount for smaller animals. Repeat treatment as needed for continued control. For the control of sheep and goat lice, apply the above solution as a dip, making sure each animal is held in vat at least 2 minutes and submerged twice during dipping.

Do not apply to lactating goats. Do not apply to dairy cattle. Do not dip calves under 1 month of age.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If on skin— Wash immediately with soap and water.

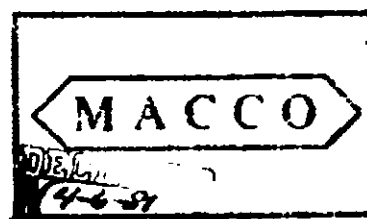
If in eyes— Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately. See side/back panels for additional precautionary statements.
