CAUTION

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. "Store in a cool dry place."

To Treat Animals: To protect cattle from attacks of stable flies horse flies, deer flies, houseflies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into the eyes. Repeat treatment as necessary when flies are troublesome.

In Animal Quarters & Milk Rooms: For rapid control of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps and Flying Moths close windows and doors and spray at the rate of one second per 1,000 cubic feet of space. For best results keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

CAUTION: Do not apply over uncovered milk or food products. Any exposed utensils or food handling surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned before use. Do not use in areas where fish or reptiles may be exposed to the spray.
