

Vegetable Insect Attack®

Ringer Vegetable Insect Attack® spray is a natural, effective control for caterpillars and worms. Insects feeding on treated plants quickly become sick, stop feeding and die.

This product appears to have no adverse effects on earthworms or on beneficial insects, such as ladybugs and praying mantids.

Can be used up to day of harvest and during storage, since there appear to be no harmful residues.

Directions for use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is specially formulated for use on fruits and vegetables as a spray. It is best applied with a tank, hose-end or hand sprayer.

Ringer Vegetable Insect Attack spray provides best control when worms and caterpillars are newly hatched. Thorough leaf coverage is important to achieve effective control.

For cutworms and armyworms, apply to foliage and soil around the plant.

For fruit and citrus trees, cover foliage thoroughly to the point of runoff.

Application rates: Mix two (2) tablespoons per gallon of water for all listed uses. Simply mix the proper amount of wettable powder with a similar amount of water. Mix into a thin paste. Then add the balance of water required. Do not store diluted spray for more than 12 hours. Mix thoroughly and agitate frequently during application. **THIS PACKAGE WILL MAKE APPROXIMATELY 18 GALLONS OF SPRAY TO TREAT 5000 SQUARE FEET OF PLANTINGS (= 7.3 billion IU/Acre).**

Can be used on all ornamental trees, shrubs and flowers.


