

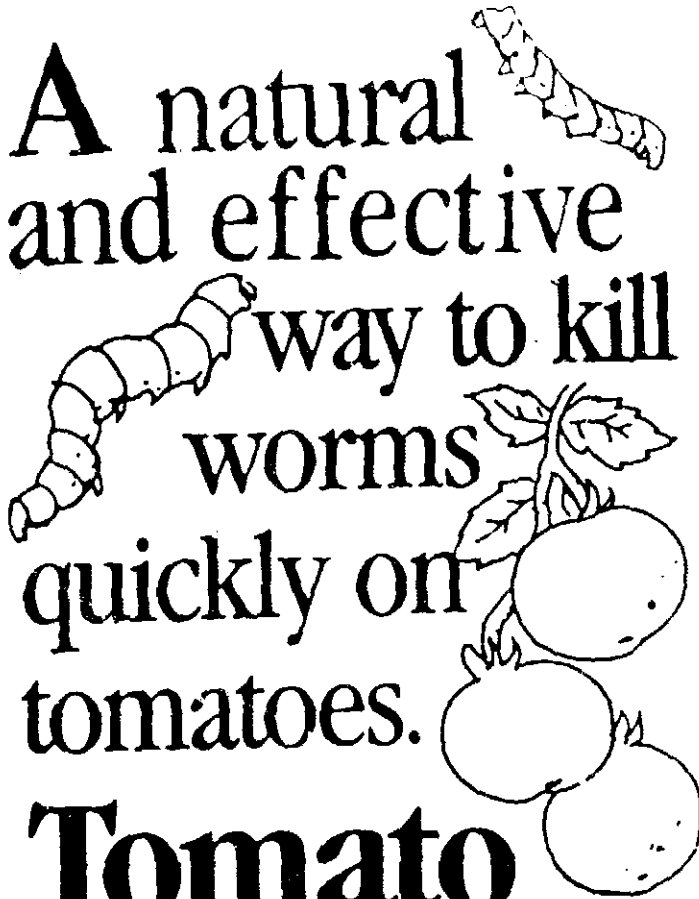

Apply to foliage at the rate of 2 to 3 ounces per 50 feet of row plantings. Repeat every 7 days or as necessary.
