For use on ornamental plants, such as trees, flowers and shrubs, in yards, fields, greenhouses or interior plantscapes.

Ringer Caterpillar Attack[®] spray is an effective control for caterpillars and worms, such as gypsy moths and tent caterpillars. Caterpillars feeding on treated foliage quickly become sick, stop feeding and die.

This product appears to have no adverse effects on earthworms or on beneficial insects, such as ladybugs and praying mantids.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is specially formulated for use on trees and shrubs as a spray with all types of hand or power sprayers. Read and carefully follow the instructions for the type of sprayer you use.

Ringer Caterpillar Attack provides best control when caterpillars are newly hatched. Therefore, apply at first sign of infestation. Thorough leaf coverage is important to achieve control. Spray both top and bottom of leaves to point of runoff.

APPLICATION RATES: Mix two (2) tablespoons per gallon of water for all listed uses. Simply mix the proper amount of wettable powder with a similar amount of water. Mix into a thin paste. Then add the balance of water required. Do not store diluted spray for more than 12 hours. Repeat applications every 7 days or as needed. Mix thoroughly and agitate frequently during application. **THIS PACKAGE WILL MAKE APPROXIMATELY 10 GALLONS OF SPRAY TO TREAT 5000 SQUARE FEET OF PLANTINGS (= 7.3 billion IU/Acre).**

Can be used on all ornamental trees, shrubs and flowers.
