The amendment referred to above, submitted in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) section 3(c)(7)(B), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. If the Agency determines that, at any time, additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data.
2. On page 1, combine the pests listed in last but one paragraph (Asian Ladybird Beetles.....) with the pests listed in the paragraph just above it, so that the same directions for use apply to all flying insect pests.

Please submit two (2) copies of final printed label for before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(a). A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

HOW TO USE:

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE.
Insect pests must be directly sprayed to be killed.

TO Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Moths, and other listed insect pests*: Prior to application, close doors and windows in the area being treated. Hold container upright and spray upward in a sweeping motion to all parts of the room. Treat areas around windows and other light sources since flying insects are attracted to these areas. Leave room after spraying. Keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes after treatment. Ventilate room when treatment is complete. Repeat treatment as necessary.

***To Kill Listed Insects:**
Asian Ladybird Beetles, Crickets, Cellar Spiders and Beetles

To Kill Cockroaches and Ants (excluding fire ants, harvester ants, pharaoh ants and carpenter ants): Insects must be directly sprayed to be killed with this product. Treat all areas infested with insects. Spray locations where ants and cockroaches may be hiding, paying special attention to areas such as cracks and crevices, areas around drains and pipes, around appliances, along baseboards, and other locations where insects may be hiding. Contact as many insects as possible as they are driven into the open from hiding places. Repeat treatment as necessary.

When treating for ants, spray ant trails, areas around doors and window frames and any other locations ants may be seen entering. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO CONTROL PAPER WASPS, YELLOW JACKETS, HORNETS, and BEES: Apply Woodstream Flying Insect Killer Aerosol at dusk or early morning when wasps, hornets, yellow jackets and bees are least active. Stand approximately 12-15 feet from the nest at a safe location with the wind to your back. Hold can upright, aim nozzle at nest, depress actuator, and spray upward into nest opening. Continue spraying until nest is completely saturated. Wait at least 24 hours before attempting to remove nest. If wasps, hornets, or bees are still active in the area around the nest, repeat treatment.

This product is non-staining to most surfaces. Do not use on surfaces that may be damaged by water. If unsure, first treat an inconspicuous area and check in a few hours for staining or damage.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL:
