

### APPLICATIONS

CECO-CIDE NB-M is used to inhibit the growth of algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial cooling water systems. Before treatment with CECO-CIDE NB-M systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. Then the system should be treated with an initial slug addition of 5.1 to 10.2 fluid ounces of CECO-CIDE NB-M per 1,000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat the initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 to 10.2 fluid ounces of CECO-CIDE NB-M per 1,000 gallons of water should be gade every 1 to 5 days or as needed. The required frequency of treatment depends on the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions of CECO-CIDE NB-M should be made to  $t^{h-}$  sump of water cooling towers.


