**CLEANING AND DEODORIZING** Whenever practical flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing use 2 1/2 to 4 ounces of MINT-FRESH per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning, remove suspended soils with a clear-water rinse, vacuum pickup or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

**DISINFECTING** Before disinfecting, pre-clean surfaces as directed above. Then prepare 2 1/2 ounces of MINT-FRESH per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. The MINT-FRESH solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean, damp cloth.

**FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING OF GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES AND OTHER GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT** It is especially important to pre-clean in order for MINT-FRESH to perform properly. Then apply a wetting solution of 8 ounces of MINT-FRESH per gallon of water.

**FOR CLEANING OF WALLS, FLOORS AND INDUSTRIAL WORK AREAS** use 2-4 ounces per gallon of water. The use of rubber gloves is recommended for personnel doing continuous wet cleaning.

MINT-FRESH may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment.

MINT-FRESH is not recommended for hospitals or nursing homes.

MINT-FRESH must not be used on food-contact surfaces.
