Dear Registrant:

The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. The identified deviation, deleting the Restricted Entry Interval, is acceptable. Due to the nature and mode of action of the product, the Agency concurs that an REI is not appropriate nor necessary to protect workers. The mode of action for NoMate PBW Fiber involves a constant release of pheromone vapor over an extended period of time (four weeks). There is no appreciable difference in inhalation exposure between application and several weeks later. Since the active ingredient has a low order of acute toxicity (Category IV) and since there is little likelihood of post-application dermal or eye contact, the Agency accepts the deviation.

Other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

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WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NEXT:

Send to EPA one (1) copy of the final printed labeling:

- BEFORE selling or distributing any product bearing the final printed labeling

AND

- WITHIN one year from date of this acceptance.



Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into mixing or application equipment. Then, dispose of empty bag in sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. The requirements in this section only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.
