

FIRST AID: If on skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION: For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint (16 fl. oz.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE:
A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 - 7.2 range and maintain.
B) Add manually or by a feeder device, sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.8 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 fl. oz.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.8 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residual are in the proper range.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do Not contaminate Water, Food or Feed by storage or disposal of cleaning of equipment.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Product or residue that cannot be used, should be diluted with water, and disposed of in a sanitary sewer.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and return to manufacturer or discard by placing in a sanitary landfill or burying in an approved land fill.
