Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Avoid swallowing. Not for indoor use. Avoid smoking while using. Direct spray away from people or animals. Allow 15 minutes before entering the treated area.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with water. Attention if irritation persists.

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperature extremes may cause leakage.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

STORAGE: Keep in a locked storage area.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE
For outdoor areas of the yard, patio and campground spray in the direction of a slight breeze. Point nozzle in the direction of the space to be treated. Press down on trigger where flying pests linger. This fog nozzle sprays to 21 feet (6.4m) away. For larger areas, best results are obtained by spraying in the direction of a slight breeze that allows the fog to drift. Spray while moving away from the treated area. A second application may be necessary.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, small flying insects. Spray from a distance of 4 to 6 feet (1.2 to 1.8 m) from these insects by directing spray from a distance of 4 to 6 feet (1.2 to 1.8 m) from flowering plants, shrubbery and grass where they are most likely to be found. Also spray around garbage cans where necessary.

Wasps, Hornets, yellow jackets and bees: Apply when insects are at rest. Aim spray at nest openings, cracks and crevices to saturate in and around nest. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, centipedes, millipedes. Spray directly on insects. Treat areas around garages and porches which are infested by these pests. Also thorough treatment of cracks and crevices.

To Control Brown Recluse Spiders, Black Widow Spiders: Spray 2 seconds at a distance of 4 to 6 feet (1.2 to 1.8 m) from the spider.

To Kill Flies and ticks on premises: Hold spray nozzle close to the insect. Apply until area is moist. DO NOT STAY IN TREATED AREA.

To Kill Tent Caterpillars: Application should be made as soon as they are first noticed. For best results apply in the morning before they have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at the caterpillars. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Gypsy Moths: Hold nozzle close to direct spray at the caterpillars. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary.
