

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For Fleas and Ticks, hold container upright 4 to 6 inches from dog's hair. Point nozzle toward animal (shield eyes and face from spray) and use a firm, fast stroke to get proper spray mist. Spray until coat of animal is damp with FLEA-RID SPRAY. Make sure spray wets ticks thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes, face or on genitalia.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BEDDING AND KENNEL AREA

Thoroughly spray interior of kennel or animal sleeping quarters. Also spray bedding and replace with fresh bedding if necessary.
