Beef Cattle Dairy Cattle	Horn flies Lice Face flies	<p>Self-Treating Dust Bags: Place ALLEY LIVESTOCK 1% RABON[®] DUST in cotton cloth or double burlap bag or any commercially available weather-proof cattle dust bag. Protect cloth or burlap bags from weather.</p> <p>Hang the bag so the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the topline of the cattle. For reduction of face flies, the bags must be located so the cattle will use them daily and must be hung so the faces of the cattle will be dusted.</p> <p>Forced Use: Suspend bags in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed, or minerals. Bags may also be suspended in front of protected mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows, bags may be suspended in milking barn exits.</p> <p>Free Choice: Suspend bags in loafing sheds, holding pens, feedlots, near watering holes or other areas where cattle gather daily.</p> <p>Hand Dusting: Apply approximately 2 oz. of dust by shaker can, rotary duster or by spoon to the tailhead, back, neck and perineum, and to the face. Rub in lightly to carry the dust beneath the hair, but do not apply with bare hands. Use dust mitt or other protective glove. Repeat as necessary.</p>
