

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this production a manner inconsistent with its labeling. To control algae and bacterial slimes, use STRIKE BAC MICROBIOCIDE as directed. For best results, slug feed. The frequency of addition of microbiocide needed depends on many factors. To optimize your use of STRIKE SAC MICROCIOCIDE follow this procedure. Recirculating Cooling Towers

- Initially use 6 fluid ounces per 1000 gallors of water to be treated (20 ppm active qualernary)
  - Should the above dosage not give satisfactory results, use 9 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water.
  - Repeat the initial dose every seven days or increase the frequency if needed.
- When the above treatment level is successful, use 2 to 3 fluid ounces per 1 000 gallons. of water to maximize efficiency. Repeat weekly as needed.
  - Should slime develop again, go back to initial dosage.

Cooling tower waters that are inherently low in algae growth and bacteria count may be adequately controlled by the lower range of these dosages; slug fed every seven days. Dilute the appropriate amount of STRIKE BAC MICROBIOCIDE in 1 or 2 gallons of water. then add to the tower. Note, this product weighs 7.73 lbs per gallon (at 20 C). Should tower be heavily fouled a precleaning is required.

Oil Field Water Flood or Salt Water Disposal Systems: (Do not apply in Marine and Estuarine

- For the control of slime forming and sulfate reducing bacteria in oilfield water flood or salt water disposal systems, add 5-10 ppm (active) STRIKE BAC MICROBIOCIDE (11/2 - 3 gallons per 3000 barrels of water) continuously. Levels for effective control will vary depending on conditions at the site.
- For intermittent use, dose at a rate of 5-20 ppm (active) STRIKE BAC MICROBIOCIDE (112 - 6 gallons per 3000 barrels of water) for 4-8 hours per day, one to four times a week as needed to maintain control

Add STRIKE BAC MICROBIOCIDE directly from the drum with the proper type of inetering equipment. This product weighs 7.73 lbs. gallon (at 20.C).
