**Statement of Practical Treatment**

will not damage tile, concrete, metal or plastics.  
Strike Bac Pool Algicide II keeps pool water free and sparkling, clear of visible algae,  
slime and green-brown colors.  
Strike Bac Pool Algicide II improves filter operation and cuts down need for other  
chemicals.  
Strike Bac Pool Algicide II imparts tone and a pleasant "feel" to swimming pool water.  
Effective against green algae (*Ankistrodesmus falcatus*, *Chlorella pyrenoidosa*) and blue-  
green algae (*Calothrix parviflora*, *Nostoc* sp., *Oscillatoria* sp. and *Phormidium* sp.).  
**NOTE:** For maximum effectiveness distribute dosage around pool edges or near pump  
where it can mix uniformly into the circulating water. Allow adequate time for thorough  
mixing before re-entering pool (at least ten minutes). Clean pool of debris prior to  
treatment. DO NOT mix with other chemicals; add directly to pool water.  
May be used in all sizes and types of pools and is compatible with most waters and  
chemicals normally used in swimming pools. Does not require special equipment.

**Directions for Use**

**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with  
its labeling.  
**Initial Application:** To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 50,000 gallons of water,  
or ratio thereof.  
**Maintenance Dose:** Use one quart per 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days.  
When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as  
necessary.  
**Booster Dose:** Immediately after every rain add one quart per 50,000 gallons of  
water as above.  
**Important:** Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used.  
Algae growth must be fought at all times.
