

For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

"Environmental Hazard" section should be placed under the Precautionary Statements section. Therefore, you will now have two subheadings under the Precautionary Statements i.e., "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animal", and "Environmental Hazards." The Storage and Disposal section should be made part of the Directions for Use.

Also add the following: Your directions on the label should be introduced by the following heading: "Directions for Use."
