The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to update your label in accordance with PR Notice 95-1, will be acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label.

Under the heading "Environmental Hazards" add the following statements:

"This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other water unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

This "Environmental Hazard" section should be placed under the Precautionary Statements section. Therefore, you will now have two subheadings under the Precautionary Statements i.e., "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animal", and "Environmental Hazards." The Storage and Disposal section should be made part of the Directions for Use.

Also add the following: Your directions on the label should be introduced by the following heading: "Directions for Use."

In use dilution, it is non-corrosive and non-staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals. Has a pleasant mint odor.

#### USE DILUTIONS:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR RESTROOMS AND GENERAL DISINFECTION** of hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces, (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in public rooms, offices, and industrial areas.

**CLEANING AND DEODORIZING:** Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing, use 5 to 8 ounces of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device.
