DIRECTION: Before placing dispenser in use, hand spray the air to prime the area. For best effect, hang dispenser 6' or more above the floor and in a location where moving air will carry the particles throughout the desired area. One dispenser should treat up to 6,000 cubic feet, dependent on the rate of air change. Should you wish to actuate MICRO MIST Air Sanitizer manually, close the doors and windows, fill the room with mist and leave the room closed for 15 minutes. Thereafter, use of the MICRO MIST Dispenser will continue cycles of sanitation with each automatic dispense.
