#### NURSING PUPPIES AND KITTENS

Spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub into coat.

PETS' SLEEPING QUARTERS Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, waltcracks and local area of floors if mosquitoes, gnats or flies are STORAGE: Store in cool area present spray lightly into the air laway from heat or open flame.
