DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Thoroughly soak animal with warm water taking 2 - 3 minutes to wet hair. Apply Flea Off Shampoo on head and ears and lather; then repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. Let animal stand 3 - 5 minutes (this is an important part of the grooming procedure), then rinse animal thoroughly.

In extremely dirty, or scaly animals the above procedure may be repeated. Flea Off-Shampoo may be used every 7 - 10 days as directed by your veterinarian.

HORSES: Controls stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies. Avoid contact with eyes or other sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not transfer contents to another container.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-use empty container. Rinse thoroughly and wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
