PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAUTION

HAZARD TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed in the skin. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with the skin. Wash face and hands with soap and water after use and before smoking or eating.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush immediately with clean water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill and repel Fleas and Ticks on cats and dogs, thoroughly mix 1/2 fluid ounce (one tablespoonful) of FLEA OFF DIP with 1 gallon of warm water.

Bathe animal with a good cleaning shampoo. Rinse well with warm water and while still wet, sponge or dip the animal with the diluted Flea Off Dip solution, making sure all areas are soaked. Do Not Rinse Off. Let dip dry on animal. For outside animals or in resistant flea areas use 1 ounce (2 tablespoonfuls) to one gallon water. Do not use more than once every 3-4 weeks.

FOR KENNEL and YARD SPRAY: Thoroughly mix 2 1/2 ounces to one half gallon of water (covers 500 sq. ft.). Remove animals before spraying. Spray only ground, grass, runs and pets' quarters. Do not spray vegetation, plants or trees with this concentration. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered Flea and Tick Control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

Repeat treatment if necessary.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL: Store in a cool place away from heat and open flame.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and put into trash.
