ADAMS SURFACE SPRAY

Precautionary Statements Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Name: May be harmful if swallowed. Avoided through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and avoid adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with clothes and clothing. Do not allow children to touch treated surface until spray has dried. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

Do not use in commercial or industrial areas, or in areas in the home, school, office, surfaces and contents should be covered during treatment. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Do not eat or drink from treated surface until spray has dried.

Acute: Harmful to fish and shellfish. Do not apply to water. Do not apply to fish or shellfish. Do not apply to water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of streams, rivers, ponds, lakes, marshes and wetlands. Do not apply where runoff is likely.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If On Skin: In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Thoroughly launder clothing before wearing again.

Note to Physician: Chlorpyrifos is a Cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine by injection is antidote of choice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use only in homes and non-food areas. Do not use in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a cool, dry place. Do not use if container is damaged. Do not use if contents are empty.

General: Use ADAMS Surface Spray as a spot treatment to control roaches, waterbugs, silverfish, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a contact spray to localized areas where pests are found. Do not spray surfaces until well treated as needed.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Scentbugs: Use areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to trails also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby tracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. Treat pets with one of our registered Flea and Tick Control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

Fleas and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing populations of these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also use dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Fleas and mosquitoes which rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
