Use Only in a Well Ventilated Area

Remove safety cap and insert sprayer. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a towel, fast staple, to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With finger tips rub into face around mouth, nose, and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the tufted hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

Directions for Use (continued):

PUPPIES and KITTENS

Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens, spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub in with your finger tips.

PETS SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and focal area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed too. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered Flea and Tick Control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

HORSES

To control stable flies, house flies, deer flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL
