The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(B), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) or FIFRA sec. 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. The acute dermal, acute inhalation and acute skin irritation studies submitted acceptable and based on their acute toxicities the product was assigned the following categories:

Based on the complete acute toxicity profile, please make the following changes to the precautionary and statement of practical treatment statements:

a. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements as follows:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

b. Add the heading Statement of Practical Treatment to the labeling and the following statements:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of

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throat with finger (optionally language:
or if available by administering syrup
of ipecac). If person in unconscious,
do not give anything by mouth and do not
induce vomiting.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get
medical attention.

3. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before
you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79
Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration
will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec.
6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes
acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS

Do not use on puppies and kittens under 4 weeks of age. For puppies and kittens over 4 weeks of age, treat the same as described for dogs and cats.

PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS

For kennels and living quarters, dust bedding and floor at the rate of 1 oz. per 50 sq. ft. of surface. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry location. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Keep cap tightly closed when not in use to avoid moisture absorption. Do not transfer contents to other containers.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in newspaper and put in trash.
