HORSES

Before application, remove dirt or debris, by brushing or washing with a mild detergent. When areas are completely dry, apply a light film to affected areas massaging into the skin daily for 2 to 3 days. Then apply every 3 to 5 days as needed. For ticks, cover the tick with the lotion and stand a few minutes before removing tick.

Dogs, Puppies, Cats, Kittens

To Kill Ear Mites: Clean ear with ADAMS OTC EAR CLEANER to remove built up wax and dirt. Gently dry ear with a cotton ball or soft cloth and apply a thin film of Adams EQUINE REPELLENT LOTION. The lotion may be applied daily for 7 to 10 days or as directed by your veterinarian. To Kill Ticks: Make sure lotion covers

To Use as a Repellent: Spread lotion lightly on water and sunny surfaces of the toes to the primary entry infested area. Repeat only as needed.
