Contains two insecticide systems and two repellents for use on horses for immediate and residual control of face flies, stable flies, house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, mites, chiggers and lice.

HORSES

Thoroughly brush the horse's coat, prior to application, to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, and as a preparation for show grooming, clean the coat with ADAMS KLEAN SHAMPOO. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying MIST/WIPE.

Cover entire surface of animal with spray, but avoid getting product into horse's eyes or other sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Brush coat against grain while spraying to insure adequate penetration of product. As a wipe, apply liberally with a clean cloth or sponge. Make sure spray has completely dried before covering with any tack.

DOGS

Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With finger tips, rub into face, around mouth, nose and eyes. Next spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing lets last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired animals, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks.

For initial treatment, apply Equine "Residual" Fly Mist/Wipe daily for 2 - 3 days. As infestation subsides, repeat treatment every 5 - 10 days or as prescribed by a veterinarian. Also re-apply every time animal is washed or exposed to a heavy rain.

NURSING PUPPIES AND KITTENS

Spray only along back or on your fingertips and rub into coat.

PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS
Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is also sprayed. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

HORSES

To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat treatment as needed.
