This amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable, provided that you:

- Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- Make the labeling changes listed below to be compliance with PR Notice 96-6 (Pet Pesticide Product Label Statements):
 - a. Add to front panel, "READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE." "USE ONLY ON DOGS AND HORSES."
 - b. Revise the statement "Avoid treatment of nursing puppies, kittens and foals under 6 weeks of age unless prescribed by a veterinarian." to "Do Not Use on nursing puppies and foals under 12 weeks of age."
 - c. Add "Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, medicated or nursing animals.". "Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water Tf sions continue.

- 3. On the front panel change "...TICKS INCLUDING IXODES DAMMINI THAT TRANSMIT LYME DISEASE AND LICE" to "...TICKS INCLUDING IXODES DAMMINI THAT MAY TRANSMIT LYME DISEASE AND LICE".
- 4. The precautionary statements must appear under the heading "Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, Warning".
 - d. Revise the precautionary paragraph to read as follows: "Human: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear safety glasses. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin eyes or clothing. Wear waterproof gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Do not contaminate foodstuffs. Do not smoke while using.

Animal: Do not get in eyes or mucous membranes. Do not use on cats. Do not use on horses intended for slaughter. Do Not Use on nursing puppies, and foals under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, medicated or nursing animals. "Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.".

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

HORSES

Thoroughly brush the horse's coat, prior to application, to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, and as a preparation for show grooming, clean the coat with a good cleansing shampoo. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying Adams Fly Spray and Repellent. Cover entire surface of animal with spray, but avoid getting product into horse's eyes or other sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Brush coat against grain while spraying to insure adequate penetration of product. As a wipe, apply liberally with a clean cloth or sponge. Make sure spray has completely dried before covering with any tack. For initial treatment, apply ADAMS Fly Spray and Repellent daily for 2-3 days. As infestation subsides, repeat treatment every 5-10 days or as prescribed by a veterinarian. Also re-apply every time animal is washed or exposed to a heary rain.
