PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

HUMAN: Avoid if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid contamination of food. Wash hands with soap and water after using. **ANIMAL:** Do not use on puppies, kittens or foals less than 6 weeks of age unless prescribed by a veterinarian. Some animals, especially cats, may be sensitive to pyrethrins. If adverse reactions occur (e.g. urinary tract irritation, breathing problems, tremors, etc.), cease use immediately and consult your veterinarian. **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish. Do not add directly to water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before using.

DOGS AND CATS: To kill fleas, ticks and lice thoroughly wet a half surface of ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP with 1 gallon of water. For outdoor animals in areas of severe infestation a half surface of infestation per coat may be used. Do not allow more than one coat in a 24 hour period.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

If animal's coat is very dirty, begin first with ADAMS PLEA AND TACK SHAMPOO. Do should be applied to dry or damp

DIRECTIONS FOR USE CONTINUED

that will coat. Sprinkle dip or spray animal with diluted ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP making sure all areas are treated to the skin. Let coat dry on animal. DO NOT RINSE OFF.

HORSES: Drench and apply as directed for dogs and cats. **WARNING:** Do not use on horses less than 6 months of age. In the presence of environmental, extended resistance and repellent activity has been demonstrated with ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP. Use as directed by your veterinarian and as often as necessary without regard to restrictions on frequency of dosing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not transfer contents to other containers.

DISPOSAL: Do not flush contents down drains and into sewer. Dispose in a secure manner. Do not reuse.
