INDICATIONS: Adams Animal Repellent
concentrate contains two insecticide systems and a
repellent for use on animals for immediate and
temporary control of face flies, stable flies, horse
flies, deer flies, fleas, ticks, mosquitoes, gnats,
mites, chiggers, lice and house flies.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this
product in a manner inconsistent with its
labeling.

HORSES: Thoroughly brush the horse's coat
prior to application to remove loose dirt and
debris. For dirty horses, and as a preparation
for show grooming, clean the coat with a good
cleansing shampoo. Use at a 1 to 4 ratio with
water. Put required amount of concentrate into
sprayer or mixing container and add
appropriate amount of water (one pint of
concentrate makes five pints of spray).

Cover entire surface of animal with spray, but
avoid getting product into horse's eyes or other
sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Spray
horse's coat especially around shoulders,
flanks, neck and legs. Brush coat against
grain while spraying to insure adequate
penetration of product.

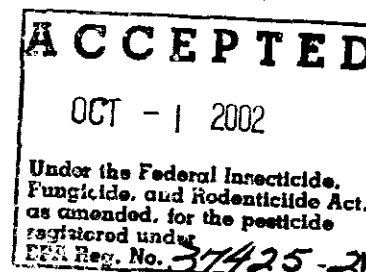
Make sure application has completely dried on
hair coat before covering with tack. As a wipe,
apply liberally with a clean cloth or sponge.
For initial treatment, apply Adams Animal
Repellent Concentrate daily. As infestation
subsides and protection builds, reapply every
2-3 days as needed. Also reapply every time
animal is washed or exposed to a heavy rain.

with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a
proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest
until damp. With fingertips, rub into face,
around mouth, nose and eyes. Next spray
neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs
last. For best penetration of spray to the skin,
direct spray against the natural lay of the hair.
On longhaired animals, rub your hand against
the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair
directly behind the hand. Make sure spray
thoroughly wets ticks.

For initial treatment, apply Adams Animal
Repellent concentrate every two to three days if
needed. Use at a 1 to 4 ratio with water. Put
the required amount of concentrate into
sprayer or mixing container and add
appropriate amount of water (one pint of
concentrate makes five pints of spray). As
infestation subsides and protection builds,
reapply every 2 to 3 weeks if necessary or as
prescribed by a veterinarian. Also reapply
every time animal is washed or exposed to a
heavy rain. Depending on reinfestation levels
in the animal's environment extended
insecticide and repellent actions have been
demonstrated with Adams Animal Repellent
Concentrate.

FOR KENNEL AND YARD SPRAY:

Thoroughly mix concentrate as a 1 to 4 ratio
with water. Put the required amount into
sprayer or mixing container and add
appropriate amount of water (one pint of
concentrate makes five pints of spray).
Remove animals before spraying. Spray only
ground, grass, runs and pet's quarters. Do not
spray vegetation, plants or trees with this
concentration. Repeat treatment if necessary.

HUMAN:
