SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

DOGS AND CATS: To kill fleas, ticks and lice thoroughly mix one ounce (2 tablespoons) of Adams Residual Dip/Wipe with 1 gallon of warm water. For outdoor animals in areas of severe infestation, two ounces (4 tablespoons) may be used. If animal's coat is dirty, bathe first with Adams Flea and Tick Shampoo or Adams Tearless Shampoo. Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. Dip animal with diluted Adams Residual Dip/Wipe making sure all areas are soaked to the skin.
