SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

DOGS: To kill fleas, ticks and lice thoroughly mix one ounce (2 tablespoons) of Adams 14 Day Flea Dip with 1 gallon of warm water. For outdoor dogs in areas of severe infestation, two ounces (4 tablespoons) may be used. If dog's coat is dirty, bathe first with Adams Flea and Tick Shampoo.

Directions For Use (continued)

Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) or diluted Adams 14 Day Flea Dip making sure to the skin. Let drip dry on dog. DO NOT RINSE on reinfestation levels in the dog's environment. Insecticide and repellent activity up to 14 days against ticks has been demonstrated with Flea Dip.*

DOG'S ENVIRONMENT: For comprehensive and biting flies, it is essential to control both on premises, use Adams Surface Spray or other insecticide premise spray.
