### Dear Mr. Washburn:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Revise the Precautionary Statements as follows:
  - a. Replace "Causes eye injury" with "Causes irreversible eye damage".
  - b. Add "Avoid contact with skin." after "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin".
  - c. Replace "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling." with "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco."

- 2. Under the Environmental Hazards statement add to the beginning of the paragraph "This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms."
- 3. Add "Contains petroleum distillate" under the Ingredients statement.
- 4. Under the Ingredients Statement, replace "Inert Ingredients" with "Other Ingredients"

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE

**DOGS:** Avoid contact with eyes or mucous membranes. To kill fleas, ticks and lice thoroughly mix one ounce (2 tablespoons) of ADAMS 14 DAY FLEA DIP with 1 gallon of warm water. For outdoor dogs in areas of severe infestations 2 oz. (4 tablespoons) may be used.

If dog's coat is dirty, bathe first with Adams Flea and Tick Shampoo. Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. Dip dog with diluted ADAMS 14 DAY FLEA DIP making sure all areas are soaked to the skin. Let drip dry on dog. DO NOT RINSE OFF! Do not reapply product for 14 days against fleas and 4 days against ticks.

Do not use on puppies less than 12 weeks old. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

#### DOG'S ENVIRONMENT:

For comprehensive control of fleas, ticks, and biting flies it is essential to control both eggs and larvae, which occur both indoors and outdoors. To control fleas and ticks on dog premises, use Adams Surface Spray or other EPA registered insecticide premise spray.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame. Do not transfer contents to other containers.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
