The statement "For Residential/home lawns" is displayed prominently on the front panel of the label and on the box. Five copies of labels are enclosed.

To support this action, the PM has already considered the following information:

- 1) our marketing is limited to veterinarians and pet stores, so it would be highly unlikely that this product could be distributed to farmers or golf courses, which is the point of adding the required language to the brand name,
- 2) we only make this product in an 8 ounce size, so the cost and inconvenience for large scale commercial use would be prohibitive
- 3) there are competitor products labeled for the same uses which contain permethrin but do not have a qualification in their brand name

This notification is consistent with provisions of PR Notice 95-2 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 95-2 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

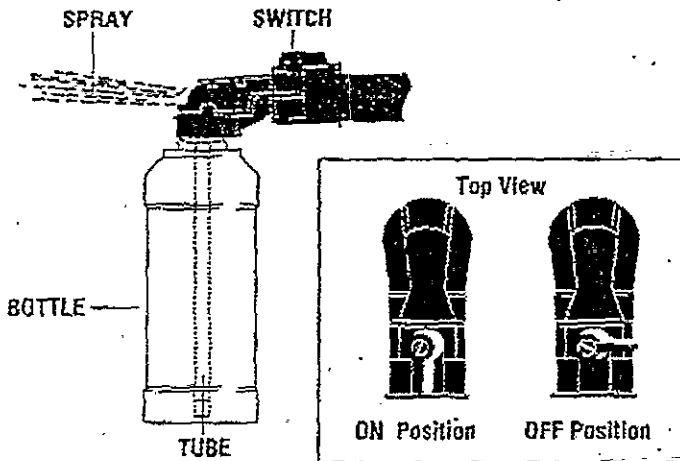
