On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
  - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 37425-32".
  - b. The signal word should be changed from "CAUTION" to "DANGER" in all parts of the label.
  - c. The Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals text should be revised to read: "Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Due to corrosive nature, may be harmful or fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, or on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

- d. In accordance with 40 CFR 156.10(h)(2)(i), add the following Statement of Practical Treatment to your label:

**If in Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Call a physician.

**If Swallowed:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are unavailable, drink large quantities of water. Induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting in an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol. **Note to Physician:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**If on Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.


- e. The following must be prominently displayed on the front panel of the label: **For Sale to and Use by Veterinarians Only.**

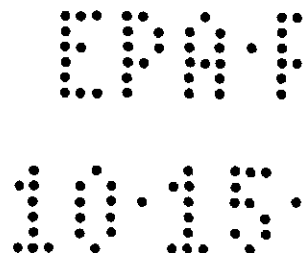

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans

### CAUTION

### DOGS AND CATS

Remove safety cap and insert sprayer. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

## NURSING PUPPIES AND KITTENS

floors. If mosquitoes, gnats,  
or flies are present, spray  
lightly into the air. Repeat  
bedding needed. The pet's bedding  
should be sprayed, make  
sure the area beneath  
bedding is also sprayed. After  
spray has dried, remove  
bedding and replace with  
fresh bedding. Treat pup  
with one of our registered  
flea and tick control products  
before allowing them to enter  
treated area.

## HORSES

To control stable flies, house  
flies, deer flies and face flies,  
apply to face, legs, flank  
top line and other body areas  
commonly attacked by these
