The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended changing the formulation is acceptable. The Confidential Statement Of Formula submitted with your application is acceptable and has been made a part of the record for this product.

The draft labeling submitted with your application is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

1) Change the precautionary labeling to read as follows:

"Causes substantial but temporary eye irritation. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear safety glasses. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."

2) Under "If Swallowed", the "Note to Physician" is no longer necessary.

Submit two copies of the corrected finished printed labeling before the product is released for shipment under this revised labeling.

A copy of the review of the eye irritation study is enclosed for your records.

Remove safety cap and insert sprayer. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes.

Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks.

Repeat treatment as needed.

**NURSING PUPPIES AND KITTENS**

Spray only along back of on your fingertips and rub into coat.

**PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS**

Spray around baseboard windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floor. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is also sprayed. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

**HORSES**

To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat treatment as needed. Caution: do not use on horses intended for food
