The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Delete the sentence "If treatment is necessary, use special instructions." Any special instructions must be part of the product label.

Revise the last sentence of the directions for use on horses as follows: Do not use on horses intended for slaughter.

Since this product is for sale to and use by veterinarians only, the storage and disposal instructions must be revised as follows:

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food and feed by storage and disposal

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat and open flame. Do not transfer contents to other containers.

Pesticide disposal. Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if

Use Only in a Well Ventilated Area

DOGS AND CATS

Remove safety cap and insert sprayer. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stoke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Reapply every 14 days.

PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats, or flies are present spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed making sure the area beneath the bedding is also sprayed. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

HORSES

To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attached by these flies. Reapply every 14 days. Do not use on horses intended for food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame. Do not contaminate water, food, of feed by storage or disposal. Do not transfer contents to other containers.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
