For dogs in areas of severe infestation, 2 ounces (4 tablespoons) may be used. If dog's coat is dirty, bathe first with Adams or Mycodex shampoos. Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. Dip dog with diluted a Fastact 2TM Long-Acting Flea and Tick Dip making sure all areas are soaked to the skin. Let dip dry on dog.
