On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 37425-39."
- b. Add the signal word "**CAUTION**" to the keep out reach of children statement.
- c. Add the following precautionary statement to the label:

- d. The statement of practical treatment must be revised to read as follow:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If On skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If Swallowed: Call a physician immediately.

- e. For Horn flies revise the label to read statement "Controls horn flies for up to 2 months."
- f. On the right panel, revise the claim for horse flies and stable flies to read "Aids in the Control of horse and stable flies."
- g. Delete the statement "A Durasect application gun is recommended xxx etc" and replace with the following statement. This statement should appear following the Ready to Use instructions.

"Durasect Long-Acting Livestock Pour On is to be used in conjunction with the Durasect application gun. Do not use this product as a spray."

- h. Delete "Non-Systemic" on the front panel.
- i. Add sheep and goats to the first bullet of the front panel statement.
- j. Revise the fifth sentence under Environmental Hazards Statement to read:

"Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

Note that your July 27, 1995 submission will be reviewed at a later date. When completed, we will inform you of the results.

3. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

ANIMAL TREATMENTS:

Lactating and Non-Lactating Dairy Cattle, Beef Cattle, and Calves

Target Insects: Controls Horn Flies, Face Flies, Stable Flies, Lice, and Aids in the Control of Horse Flies.

Application:* Apply along back and down face. Use 1/2 fl. oz. (15ml) per 100 lbs. body wt. of animal, up to 5 fl. oz. for any one animal.

Sheep

Target Insects: Sheep Keds, Lice

Application:* Apply along back. Use 1/4 fl. oz. (7.5ml) per 50 lbs. body wt. of animal, up to a maximum of 3 fl. oz. for any one animal.

Goats

Target Insect: Lice

Application:* Apply along back. Use 1/4 fl. oz. (7.5ml) per 50 lbs. body wt. of animal, up to a maximum of 3 fl. oz. for any one animal.

Repeat treatment as needed, but not more than once every 2 weeks. For optimum lice control a double treatment at 14 day intervals is recommended.

Special Note: DURASECT Long Acting Livestock Pour-On is not effective in controlling cattle grubs.

* A DURASECT application gun is recommended for convenient and accurate dosing.
