IF IN EYES: Flush with water for fifteen minutes. Call a physician.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, or gelatin solution. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

3. The Confidential Statement of Formula with the Foraperle 303 is acceptable. We are evaluating the alternate formulation and will contact you if we find it to be acceptable.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
