

The proposed amendment to the registration cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, And Rodenticide Act, as amended revising the label is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

- 1) The statement, "Do not use on dogs or cats under 12 weeks of age.", must appear on the label.
- 2) Revise the statement, "Consult a veterinarian xxxxx under 12 weeks of age." to read "Consult a veterinarian xxxxx or nursing animals."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

WARNING

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Only in a Well Ventilated Area

DOGS AND CATS

Remove safety cap and insert sprayer. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs and cats, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Reapply every 3 weeks.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Call Physician. Flush eyes with gentle stream of water for 15 minutes.

IF SWALLOWED: Call Physician or Poison Control Center. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, or gelatin mixture, or if these are unavailable, a large quantity of water.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
