Subject: Amendment - Revised Labeling & Formula Deleting  
Pentachlorophenol  
Positive Weed Control  
EPA Registration No. 37594-15  
Your Submission Dated December 4, 1986

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Move the headings "Precautionary Statements" and "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" to the paragraph on the right panel, which starts with "Harmful or Fatal If Swallowed or Absorbed."
  - b. Delete the duplicate statements "Harmful if swallowed" through "Get medical attention if irritation persists." The statements that duplicate the Statement of Practical Treatment can be deleted.
  - c. Move "This product is poisonous to fish" to the Environmental Hazards Section.
  - d. Delete "Keep out of lakes, ponds, and streams. Do not apply in any manner not specified on label."

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The amended labeling and formulation supersede all previously accepted ones.

Please note we usually do not review or stamp accepted distributor labeling. For future submission, submit the labeling for Trigon Corporation.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

SUNRISE POSITIVE WEED CONTROL is a specially formulated  
non-selective chemical for controlling a wide range of annual and  
perennial weeds and grasses. It is recommended for use only on  
non-cropland areas such as railroad rights-of-way and industrial  
sites. The degree of control and duration of results will vary with the  
amount of SUNRISE POSITIVE WEED CONTROL applied, soil  
type, rainfall and other conditions. Highly recommended for municipal  
weed control ~~public~~.

## DIRECTIONS

To control most weeds and grasses on non-cropland areas such as  
railroad rights-of-way and industrial sites for an extended time,  
apply 4.5 gallons per acre of undiluted SUNRISE POSITIVE WEED  
CONTROL after the most predominant weeds have been emerged.  
No agitation is required. SUNRISE POSITIVE WEED CONTROL  
should be applied with railroad on-track, truck mounted, or other  
standard spraying equipment. For treating small areas, a tank-type  
hand sprayer or sprinkling can may be used.

User should consult experiment station or extension service weed  
specialists for recommendations as to use of SUNRISE POSITIVE

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or  
feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is  
prohibited. Do not store this product near

Product subjected to sub-freezing temperatures  
should be warmed to at least 60°F and agitated
