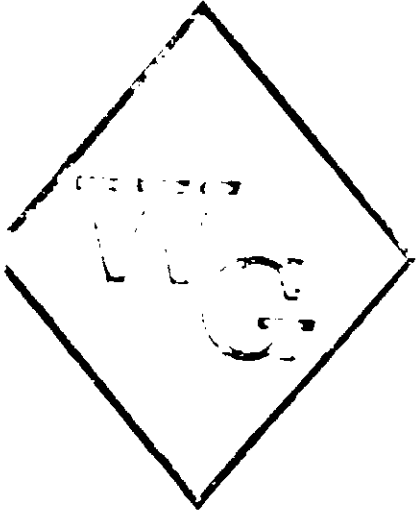

Do not use in potable water systems. Application should be made to systems when the presence of microbial contamination is first noticed. Water cooling towers which are heavily contaminated should be cleaned manually before treatment. This product must be added at a place in the system where it will be uniformly mixed with the circulating water.

Initial Dose: If algae or microbial slime are visible, add a slug addition of 17.5 to 26.4 ounces (by weight) of Water Guard #165 per one thousand gallons of water in the system (131 ppm to 198 ppm by weight). Repeat daily until control is evident.

Subsequent Dose: Once control is achieved, add 8.9 to 17.5 ounces (by weight) of Water Guard #165 per one thousand gallons of water in the system (66 ppm to 131 ppm by weight) once a week, or as needed. For application by proportioning pump, these dosages should be calculated on the basis of each one thousand gallons of bleed-off.

First Aid:

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Store this product away from food and feed.

External: In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Eyes: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

Internal: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not immediately available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge treated effluent from cooling towers where it will drain into lakes, ponds, or streams. Do not rinse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying.
