DIRECTIONS

Master Brand Livestock Spray is a quality insecticide that will provide effective and economical control of HORSE FLIES, LICE and TICKS on BEEF CATTLE also LICE on HOGS.

LICE ON HOGS: One gallon per 100 gallons of water. Apply a complete coverage spray to animals, pens and litter. One treatment may be sufficient. Repeat application only as needed. Avoid contamination of feed, food containers and watering troughs.

HORSE FLIES ON BEEF CATTLE: Use 1 to 1/2 gallons per 100 gallons of water. Apply a complete coverage of spray. Repeat application at 2 week intervals if needed.

LICE ON BEEF CATTLE: Use 1 gallon per 100 gallons of water. Apply a complete coverage of spray. One application may be sufficient. Repeat application only as needed.

TICKS ON BEEF CATTLE: Use 1 to 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water. Apply a complete coverage of spray. Repeat application at two week intervals if needed.

DO NOT APPLY SPRAY TO MILKING CATTLE.

DO NOT TREAT CALVES UNDER ONE MONTH OF AGE.

When applying spray, avoid contamination of feed, food containers and watering troughs.

BACK RUBBING DEVICES: For reduction of Lice, use two quarts with 12½ gallons of fuel oil. Make device easily accessible to each 15 to 40 head of cattle. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks.

DO NOT USE ON DAIRY ANIMALS.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Flammable. Avoid prolonged breathing of spray mist. Avoid repeated or prolonged contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Keep out of the reach of children. Keep containers closed and away from heat and flames.

Malathion, after repeated, prolonged or careless use may cause Cholinesterase inhibition. ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL.
