

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 Fill tank with water before adding this product and allow to stand five minutes before using.

DIRECTIONS LAST TANK ONLY:

1. Empty and clean sprayer and ground wherever possible.
2. Wash with a detergent.
3. Rinse with clear water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1.5 oz. of SANITIZER to 15 gallons water (provides 100 ppm available chlorine). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or disinfected to air dry only.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
