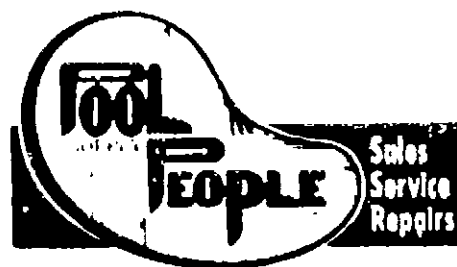

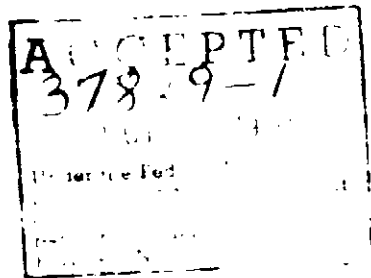

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

For new pools: Spring start-up: superchlorinate with one (1) pint (16 fl. oz.) of The Pool Supply People sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE:

- A. Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 - 7.8 range and maintain.
- B. Add chlorine by a feeder device. The Pool Supply People sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.8 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 fl. oz.) of The Pool Supply People sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.8 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residuals are in the proper range.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL. Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. Avoid contact with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash. Do not bury in unapproved land fill. Product or residue that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate water used for storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
