Directions to humans and domestic animals

CAUTION

This product is manufactured by All-Pure Chemical Company solely for further processing and repackaging.

When repackaged for disinfection purposes, you must use a label which is registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency with specific instructions for the disinfection usage.

Storage and Disposal:

Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. In case of large spill, attempt to contain spill and reduce with sulfite or bisulfite salts. Chemically reduced sodium hypochlorite contains sulfates and salt, and may be safely placed in a sanitary sewer. For small spills, contain spill, and flood with large quantities of water. Dispose of in sanitary sewer. Please deposit containers thoroughly, reseal with closure provided, and return to manufacturer. Product or rinsate which cannot be reprocessed or used, should be chemically reduced or diluted with water and placed in sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal or by cleaning of equipment.
