GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

All Pure Spa-Treat is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of All Pure Spa-Treat per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of All Pure Spa-Treat per 10,000 gallons of water 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 10 to 15 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 7 fluid ounces of All Pure Spa-Treat per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of All Pure Spa-Treat should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. All Pure Spa-Treat is compatible with chlorine products used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains at an alkaline pH. All Pure Spa-Treat can be used on decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and chemicals normally required. However, do not mix All Pure Spa-Treat with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of the home and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and dispose of in a plastic bag.
